Myth One

If you love me and obey my laws, I will be kind to your families for thousands of generations...

We show our love for God by obeying his commandments, and they are not hard to follow.

(Exodus 20:6, Deuteronomy 5:10, 1 John 5:3)

Myth Three

No-one is able to stick to God's guidelines.

This myth is debunked by the following Verses:

You shall be perfect with the Lord thy God...

Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.

The law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

I will tear the kingdom away from you

The LORD grew angry with Solomon, because his heart had turned away from the LORD, the God of Israel, who had appeared to him twice. Although He had warned Solomon explicitly not to follow other gods, Solomon did not observe what the LORD had commanded. Then the

LORD said to Solomon, “Because you have done this and have not kept My covenant and My statutes, which I have commanded you, I will tear the kingdom away from you and give it to your servant...

(1 Kings 11:9-11)

A king should not have many horses, wives or silver and gold

Go ahead and appoint a king, but make sure that he is an Israelite and that he is the one the Lord has chosen.

The king should not have many horses, especially those from Egypt. The Lord has said never to go back there again. And the king must not have a lot of wives—they might tempt him to be unfaithful to the Lord. Finally, the king must not try to get huge amounts of silver and gold.

(Deuteronomy 17:15-17)

King Solomon had 1000 wives and mistresses and thousands of horses; he was filthy rich

Solomon had 4,000 stalls for his chariot horses, and he had 12,000 horses. (1 Kings 4:24, 2 Chronicles 9:13-21)

Preach the gospel to all the world

Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature...

Teach them to obey everything I have commanded you...

(Mark 16:15, Matthew 28:16-20, Matthew 19:16-30)

Not kept your law or commandments

Read (Genesis 13:13, 18, 19 and Deuteronomy 29:22-26, Amos 4:11, Jeremiah 23:13-14, Matthew 10:11-15,

Matthew 11:20-24) to find out about Sodom and Gomorrah.

Pride, idleness, arrogance

Behold, this was the sin of your sister Sodom, pride, self indulgence, and laziness in her and in her daughters, neither did she help the poor and needy.

And they were haughty, and committed abomination before me: therefore I wiped them out.

What matters to Our Father

You can find the commandments at (Exodus 20) and (Deuteronomy 4 and 5).

In Hebrew, the Ten Commandments are called עשרת הדברִים (transliterated aseret ha-d'varîm) and in Mishnaic Hebrew עשרת הדברות (transliterated aseret ha-dibrot), both translatable as "the ten words," "the ten sayings", or "the ten matters."

Special treasure

Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine.
(Exodus 19:5)

We promise to obey

"We will do everything
that the LORD has spoken."
(Exodus 19:7-8)

Believe you forever

I'll come to you in a thick cloud, so that everyone can hear me talking to you and will believe you forever.
(Exodus 19:9)

Written with the finger of God; In stone

And he gave Moses, when He finished speaking with him on Mount Sinai, two tablets of testimony made from stone, written with the finger of God.

Blessings and eternal life

See, today I am setting before you a blessing and a curse: a blessing if you obey the commandments...

(Read Deuteronomy 28)

You can read up on the blessings here in five different Bible translations.

Curses and mayhem

Curses and mayhem will follow those who ignore God's love rules. Read (Deuteronomy 28:15-68)

My yoke is easy and my burden light

Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

(Matthew 11:29-30)

Our Father is merciful and will not forget the covenant

If you seek The Lord with all your heart and all your soul, you will find Him... Our Father is merciful, and He will not

abandon you or forget the covenant... (Deuteronomy 4:29-31)

Confess your sins

Confess your sins and that of your fathers... humble yourself and make amends and then I will remember my covenant... (Leviticus 26:40-42)

Submit to God

God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble. Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. (James 4:6-8)

Yom Kippur

God's yearly feast Yom Kippur helps us on a yearly basis to take stock, reconnect and resolve to do better.

Chapter Four - Life application lessons

All throughout history people are saved and rewarded for 'doing the right thing' and for living according to God's Commandments also known as Love Rules. Our Heavenly Father wrote those Rules with His own finger in stone so that they would be remembered and kept forever!

Myth Five (:grace came with Jesus) is dispelled when we read that God is a merciful God who gives grace to the humble and readily forgives those who seek Him.

When Our Heavenly Father says that He will not forget his covenant, He is referring to his Love Rules, which have mercy written within them.

Blessings and eternal life are promised to those who are obedient to God's Love Rules. We love our Father back by obeying His Love Rules.

6 You shall not murder.

7 You shall not commit adultery.

8 You shall not steal.

9 You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

10 You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is your neighbor's."

(Exodus 20:1-17)

The LORD befriends those who respect him, he reveals his secrets to them and He teaches them his covenant.

(Psalm 25:14), read also (John 15:13-15)

Treat others the way you like to be treated

In everything, treat others the way you like to be treated.

This sums up the Law and the prophets.

(Matthew 7:12)

Love foreigners

You must love foreigners: in Egypt you were foreigners yourselves. (Deuteronomy 10:19)

The same law for all

The same law and same rules that apply to you also apply to the foreigners that live with you. (Numbers 15:16)

Jesus prayed to all be as one

That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us... (John 17:21)

Idolatry

No pity; tooth for tooth

And thine eye shall not pity; but life shall go for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot. (Deuteronomy 19:21) and Jesus later clarified see (Matthew 5:38-48)

Jesus refined this

Turn the other cheek

You have heard that it was said, 'Eye for eye and tooth for tooth.' But I tell you not to resist an evil person... turn the other cheek... (Matthew 5:38-39)

If it had been impossible to obey God and keep His Commandments, Abraham would not have been able to do so.

King Hezekiah. King of Judah between 715 and 686 BC

Hezekiah kept the commandments

Hezekiah trusted in the LORD, the God of Israel. No king of Judah was like him, either before him or after him. He remained faithful to the LORD and did not turn from following Him; he kept the commandments that the LORD had given Moses. And the LORD was with Hezekiah, and he prospered wherever he went.

(2 Kings 18:5-7)

Myth Two and Three busted by King Hezekiah.

King Hezekiah (BC 717-687) fell ill and was about to die. He prayed for more time and the Lord granted him an extra 15 years!

I've heard your prayer and will heal you

Tell Hezekiah, the Lord says, I heard your prayer and seen your tears; I will heal you... And extend your life by fifteen years; and I will win your war with the king of Assyria for you; and I will defend your city...

(2 Kings 20:1-11, Isaiah 38:1-8)

Job from the Land of Uz. Time frame unknown.

Job lost everything he held dear in life and kept his faith - A perfect person and man of integrity

And the LORD said to Satan, 'Have you considered my servant Job, that there is no one like him on earth, a

perfect person, a man of integrity, he fears God, and stays away from evil?' (Job 1:8)

Twice as much as he had before

After Job had prayed for his friends, the LORD restored his fortunes and gave him twice as much as he had before. (Job 42:10)

Job is also a myth buster.

God called him 'perfect,' a man of integrity.

God's Covenant of Love

Lord, the God of heaven, the great and awesome God, who keeps his covenant of love with those who love him and keep his commandments. (Nehemiah 1:5)

Lord, the God of Israel, there is no God like you in heaven or on earth—you who keep your covenant of love with your servants who continue wholeheartedly in your way. (2 Chronicles 6:14)

Jesus said

'Ye are my friends,
if ye do whatsoever I command you.'

(John 15:13-15)

Chapter Five - Life application lessons

Myth Two and Three dispelled by Noah, Job, Abraham, Caleb, Joshua, Hezekiah and eight other kings.

Abraham and Sarah originally from Ur in Mesopotamia. 2166-1991 BC

Abraham and Sarah

Blessed with many children because of obedience

Read (Genesis 12:1-9, 15:1-21, 17:1-27)

Isaac (He will laugh). Land of Canaan between 1851-1671 BC.

Isaac descendant of Abraham and Sarah

You can read how Isaac was blessed because of his lineage in (Genesis 25:5, 26:1-6, 24-29)

Jacob was renamed Israel. Twelve tribes of Israel. between 1791-1644 BC

Jacob a descendant of Isaac and Rebecca

God appeared to Jacob again, when he came from Paddan-aram, and blessed him. And God said to him, “Your name is Jacob; no longer shall your name be called Jacob, but Israel shall be your name.” So he called his name Israel. And God said to him, “I am God Almighty: be fruitful and multiply. A nation and a company of nations shall come from you, and kings shall come from your own body. The land that I gave to Abraham and Isaac I will give to you, and I will give the land to your offspring after you. (Genesis 35:9-12)

Daniel (God is my judge). Lion’s den in Babylon between 620-540 BC

Hebrew: דָּאֲנִיֵּל, Dani’el, meaning "God is my Judge.”

Daniel was a righteous man of princely lineage who was carried off to Babylon in 605 B.C. by Nebuchadnezzar. Daniel was saved from becoming the lion's dinner because he was a faithful servant of God. (Daniel 6)

My God hath sent his angel, and shut the lions' mouths

... They brought Daniel, and cast him into the den of lions. Now the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God whom thou servest continually, he will deliver thee...

My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocence was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt. (Daniel 6:16, 22)

King Darius ruler of Babylon

King Darius wrote to all people

Then King Darius wrote to all people, nations, and languages, that live on earth; I wish you much peace.

I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom shall not be destroyed, and his dominion shall be even unto the end.

He delivers and rescues, and he works signs and wonders in heaven and on earth, and he delivered Daniel from the power of the lions. (Daniel 6:25-27)

Our God will deliver us

... who is that God that shall deliver you out of my hands? Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar... our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king.

But if not... we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which you have set up. (Daniel 3:15-18)

Apocrypha: Prayer of Azariah Chapter 1

1 And they walked in the midst of the fire, praising God, and blessing the Lord.

2 Then Azarias stood up, and prayed on this manner; and opening his mouth in the midst of the fire said,

3 Blessed art thou, O Lord God of our fathers: thy name is worthy to be praised and glorified for evermore:

4 For thou art righteous in all the things that thou hast done to us: yea, true are all thy works, thy ways are right, and all thy judgments truth.

5 In all the things that thou hast brought upon us, and upon the holy city of our fathers, even Jerusalem, thou hast executed true judgment: for according to truth and judgment didst thou bring all these things upon us because of our sins.

6 For we have sinned and committed iniquity, departing from thee.

7 In all things have we trespassed, and not obeyed thy commandments, nor kept them, neither done as thou hast commanded us, that it might go well with us.

10 And now we cannot open our mouths, we are become a shame and reproach to thy servants; and to them that worship thee.

11 Yet deliver us not up wholly, for thy name's sake, neither disannul thou thy covenant:

12 And cause not thy mercy to depart from us, for thy beloved Abraham's sake, for thy servant Isaac's sake, and for thy holy Israel's sake;

13 To whom thou hast spoken and promised, that thou wouldest multiply their seed as the stars of heaven, and as the sand that lieth upon the seashore.

14 For we, O Lord, are become less than any nation, and be kept under this day in all the world because of our sins.

15 Neither is there at this time prince, or prophet, or leader, or burnt offering, or sacrifice, or oblation, or incense, or place to sacrifice before thee, and to find mercy.

16 Nevertheless in a contrite heart and an humble spirit let us be accepted.

17 Like as in the burnt offerings of rams and bullocks, and like as in ten thousands of fat lambs: so let our sacrifice be in thy sight this day, and grant that we may wholly go after thee: for they shall not be confounded that put their trust in thee.

18 And now we follow thee with all our heart, we fear thee, and seek thy face.

19 Put us not to shame: but deal with us after thy lovingkindness, and according to the multitude of thy mercies.

20 Deliver us also according to thy marvellous works, and give glory to thy name, O Lord: and let all them that do thy servants hurt be ashamed;

21 And let them be confounded in all their power and might, and let their strength be broken;

22 And let them know that thou art God, the only God, and glorious over the whole world.

23 And the king's servants, that put them in, ceased not to make the oven hot with rosin, pitch, tow, and small wood;

24 So that the flame streamed forth above the furnace forty and nine cubits.

25 And it passed through, and burned those Chaldeans it found about the furnace.

26 But the angel of the Lord came down into the oven together with Azarias and his fellows, and smote the flame of the fire out of the oven;

28 Then the three, as out of one mouth, praised, glorified, and blessed, God in the furnace, saying,

29 Blessed art thou, O Lord God of our fathers: and to be praised and exalted above all for ever.

Myth Five busted in Prayer of Azariah (grace came only by Jesus)

“We haven’t obeyed you nor kept your commandments but are appealing to your grace and mercy.”

And they were saved with not a hair singed on their heads, because our God is a merciful and gracious God.

King Nebuchadnezzar, King of Babylon between
605 - 562 BC

Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego

Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

Therefore, I make a decree, That every people, nation, and language, which speak anything amiss against the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, shall be cut in pieces, and their houses shall be made a dunghill: because there is no other God that can deliver after this sort. (Daniel 3:28-29)

Jonah - Israel, Tarnish, Nineveh between 783-753 BC

Thanks to Jonah's message, the city of Nineveh and all its inhabitants were saved from destruction. (Jonah 1-3)

Jesus mentioned three people who did not sin. It is entirely possible not to sin.

Jesus healed them all, mostly without judgment

The Lord will deliver me

The Lord that delivered me out of the paw of the lion, and out of the paw of the bear, he will deliver me out of the hand of this Philistine. (1 Samuel 17:37) read the whole of (1 Samuel 17).

That the whole earth may know...

You come to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have taunted.

This day will the Lord deliver you into mine hand... that the whole earth may know that there is a God in Israel. (1 Samuel 17:45-47)

David defeated Goliath

David defeated Goliath with a sling and a stone. He struck him down without a sword. (1 Samuel 17:50)

Prophet Samuel spoke to king Saul and said,

You have not kept the command...

“You have acted foolishly,” Samuel declared. “You have not kept the command the LORD your God gave you; if you had, the LORD would have established your kingdom over Israel for all time. But now your kingdom will not endure; the LORD has sought a man after His own heart (David) and appointed him ruler over His people, because you have not kept the command of the LORD.” (1 Samuel 13:13-14)

King David committed adultery and had his mistress' husband killed

(Read 2 Samuel 11) to find out about the affair of King David and Bathsheba and the king's despicable behaviour.

(Read 2 Samuel 12) to find out about the consequences of King David's behaviour and God's grace (forgiveness).

You broke God's Commandment

Why did you disregard God's Commandments and do evil? You had Uriah the Hittite killed with a sword by the Ammonites, and grabbed his wife for yourself.

You broke God's Commandment when you had Uriah the Hittite killed with a sword and took his wife to be your own.

For these reasons the sword shall never depart from your house.

There will be evil against you. This evil will come from your own family and in full sight of everyone will your family come to shame and your name be defiled. What you did in the dark will be shown to the whole nation. (2 Samuel 12:1-25)

When David was confronted with what he had done, he admitted his sin. And Nathan said,

Our Father has forgiven you

Our Father has forgiven you and decided that you won't die because of this sin. However, the son born from this adulterous act will die. (2 Samuel 12:1-25)

Myth Five busted again, when once more we see a gracious and merciful God.

Many women blessed by the Lord

You can read how some of the women and matriarchs in the Bible were blessed and played an important part in history as follows,

Sarah in the Book of (Genesis 11:29, 21:1-7),

Rebekah (Isaac's wife) in the Book of (Genesis 25:21)

The Gregorian calendar

The Gregorian calendar is the calendar used in most of the world. It is named after Pope Gregory XIII, who introduced it in October 1582.

Jesus' birth date and events are known worldwide

We may be a few years out because no-one knows the exact year of Jesus' birth. But this dating system was devised in 525 by a monk named Dionysius Exiguus of Scythia Minor and is the global standard which is recognized by international institutions such as the United Nations.

The terms 'anno Domini' (AD) and 'before Christ' (BC) are used to label or number years in the Julian and Gregorian calendars. The term 'anno Domini' is Medieval Latin and means 'in the year of the Lord,' taken from the full original phrase 'anno Domini nostri Jesu Christi,' which translates to 'in the year of our Lord Jesus Christ.' The majority of countries in the world use the Gregorian calendar as their sole civil calendar. Only a few countries such as Afghanistan, Iran, Ethiopia and Nepal use a different system.

Myth Five (grace came only through Jesus) is debunked by the Second Commandment which states,

The Second Commandments states amongst other things, 'I'LL SHOW MERCY TO THOSE WHO LOVE ME, AND KEEP MY COMMANDMENTS.'

Hatred is as bad as killing (sixth Commandment referenced)

Jesus expanded on these Love Rules given out at Mount Sinai, when he gave his sermon on the mount and explained that hatred is as bad as killing and even calling someone names will get you in BIG trouble. (Matthew 5:21-22, 1 John 3:15, Matthew 5:22)

Lusting is equal to having an affair (seventh Commandment elaborated on)

Lusting after someone is as bad as having an affair. In fact, Jesus said that if you weren't able to control your eyes, hands or feet; it'd be better for you to be cutting

these off rather than letting these lead you astray.
(Matthew 5:27-30)

Be loyal (Jesus addressed and expounded on the fifth and seventh Commandment)

Deserting your wife is not according to God's wishes and deserting your parents is beastly too. (Matthew 5:32, 5:31-32 Matthew 19:7-10, Exodus 20:12, Deuteronomy 27:16, Mark 7:9-13)

Don't swear, live simply, help others (Third, ninth and tenth Commandment expounded on)

We shouldn't swear for any reason, we ought to live simply and help our neighbours. (Matthew 5:34-37, Matthew 6:25-34, Leviticus 19:18, Matthew 5:43-44)

Jesus was single

Jesus also explained that it is easier to serve The Lord when you're single and not in a relationship.

If you can... accept it.

... His disciples said to Him, "If this is the case between a man and his wife, it is better not to marry."

"Not everyone can accept this word," Jesus answered, "but only those to whom it has been given. For there are eunuchs who were born that way; others were made that way by men; and still others live like eunuchs for the sake

of the kingdom of heaven. The one who can accept this should accept it.”... (Matthew 19:8-12)

Turn the other cheek

Myth Three debunked (:No-one is able to stick to God's guidelines) Various Biblical figures followed God's Love Rules as mentioned previously, including Jesus and some of His contemporaries, and they lived blameless before the Lord, without sin. See also (John 9:3)

The Ten Commandments referred to by Christians

From (Exodus 20:1-22, Exodus 31:18)

Classic example of Commandments of men

Why is it likely that ‘the law’ referred to was the Jewish tradition of adhering to 613 commandments and not the Ten commandments which is what Christians generally refer to when they talk about God’s Law?

Below are the reasons from (Acts 15).

A meeting between elders was called because there was a dispute between newly converted believers and established believers.

The question was, ‘Should new believers be circumcised? This requirement was not included in the

Ten Commandments but was included in the 613 commandments of the Jewish tradition.

From this we know that when the elders spoke they referred to the 613 Commandments of the Jewish tradition and not God's Ten Commandments specifically. It was decided that new believers did not have to be circumcised nor follow anything else other than stick to three food laws and one moral law.

In a nutshell the Apostolic Decree states that non-Jewish believers (i.e. Christians) should abstain from food polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from the meat of strangled animals and from blood. (Acts 15:19-20)

... we did not command you to be circumcised or keep the law... (Acts 15:24)

How many Christians do you know that act according to these rules and only eat kosher meat? Or only eat meat that does not contain blood? I don't know any.

What about the sexual immorality rule; you know the one about not sleeping with someone before marriage? How many Christians care about these rules?

Most Christians I meet don't believe that they're supposed to follow the 613 Commandments, nor the Ten

nor do they follow the Apostolic Decree. They've effectively placed themselves above the law.

Why is the Apostolic Decree a classic example of commandments of men? Because they conflict with God's rules.

Contrary rules

The rules decided upon at the Jerusalem Quadrilateral conflict with God's rules because

There are ten of God's rules, not four.

God's rules are never to be changed.

1. God's rules are the same for everyone

Moses said, Keep the Commandments

Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, THAT YE MAY KEEP THE COMMANDMENTS OF THE LORD YOUR GOD which I command you.

(Deuteronomy 4:2, Deuteronomy 4:2, 12:32, Revelation 22:14-21)

Jesus said, Keep the Commandments

(Matthew 5:17-19)

Blessed are those who do His Commandments

'Blessed are those who do His Commandments and not much good will come to those who add or distract from His Word.' (Revelation 22:14-21)

Written in stone with the finger of God

Woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye donate various herbs, BUT YOU NEGLECT GOD'S DIVINE LAW; JUSTICE, MERCY, FAITHFULNESS AND THE LOVE OF GOD: you should not do one or the other but ought to practice and teach all. (Matthew 23:23, Luke 11:42, (Matthew 23:23, Luke 11:42))

Noah was a righteous man who walked with God and found grace in the eyes of our Father. (Genesis 6:8-9, 7:1).

Ancient Truth: Lesson Three
Noah responded to God's love with gratitude and compliance. Because of Noah's obedience, he and his family, eight souls were the only ones who survived.

Abraham - Circa 2000 BC

After this, a few hundred years later, only three people were saved out of four cities. There were fireworks to purify the rot and beastly behaviour that had gone on in those cities.

Three people were deemed worthy of saving out of four cities. (Genesis 13:13, Genesis 18 and 19).

Ancient Truth: Lesson Four

Whole cities may perish but we know that God can send angels to save those he deems worthy.

Moses - Circa 1500-1200 BC

After this God's children made an image of a Beast (Calf) instead of obeying the Love Rules (Commandments) that they had agreed upon with their Father.

God's Love Rules

Covenant of Love

(Ten Commandments)

1. Honour Go(o)d only and turn away from (d)evil (beastly inklings)
2. Don't make idols, images or likenesses. Don't admire them. God will have mercy on those who obey His Rules.
3. Don't use GOD's name for no good reason. Don't swear.
4. Rest one day a week and allow others to do the same.

5. Honour your parents.
6. Do not kill.
7. Do not sleep around, have affairs or cheat on your partner.
8. Do not lie
9. Do not steal
10. Do not covet (Exodus 20)

Ancient Truth: Lesson Five

God's posse was given a choice between blessings and curses and life and death. (Deuteronomy 11). It matters to God that we do the right thing.

Joshua and Caleb - Circa 1400 BC

Joshua and Caleb were the only two people out of a whole tribe of (millions) of able-bodied guys, allowed to enter the promised land because they were the only two that obeyed God.

The rest of them perished in the desert. (Deuteronomy 1:20-46, Numbers 13, 14, Deuteronomy 34:1-9 and Joshua 1).

Ancient Truth: Lesson Six

God rewards obedience, loyalty and brave and courageous behaviour in the face of adversity.

Judges - Circa 1150–1025 BC

THE CORE MESSAGE OF THE BIBLE IN A FEW PAGES

After being ruled by Judges (for around four hundred years) God's people asked for a king, 'Like all the other nations surrounding them.' (Read the Book of Judges).

Kings - Circa 960-560 BC

Over a period of around five hundred and twenty years, less than a fifth, were deemed to be 'good' kings who followed God's Commandments and didn't engage in idolatry and imagery.

Less than one fifth of leaders were obedient, chose life and set the right example. Read Book of (1 Kings, 2 Kings), and Book of (1 Chronicles), and (2 Chronicles).

Ancient Truth: Lesson Seven

Rulers and people in charge are not exempt from God's Love Rules. Don't think that anyone, including people in authority, is above God's Law.

King David - Circa 1035-970 BC

King David broke God's Commandments by committing adultery and having a man killed.

In a nutshell, King David was fallible, like all of us. Because of his remorse he was forgiven but just the same had to live with the consequences of his sins/bad behaviour.

Ancient Truth: Lesson Eight

THE CORE MESSAGE OF THE BIBLE IN A FEW PAGES

As human beings we're fallible. Our Heavenly Father knows this and is forgiving and accepts genuine remorse and regret.

Other faithful servants of The Lord

Hezekiah, Isaac, Rebekah, Jacob, Leah, Rachel, Joseph, Hannah, Manoah's wife, Zacharias and Elisabeth, Mary, Baltasar (Daniel), Shadrach (Ananias), Meshach (Misael) and Abednego (Azarias), Jonah, Job, Naomi and Ruth, Rahab, Esther and Deborah.

Ancient Truth: Lesson Nine

Some of the people mentioned above were ordinary people, like you and I, who were blessed by the Lord because of their faith and/or prayer and/or obedience. God likes to raise and reward humble people who have great faith.
